On Friday, we invite the children to wear what is comfy to them! This could be pyjamas, jogging bottoms or even a dress - whatever your child finds comfy!

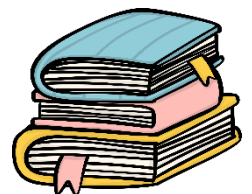
Read for 10:
