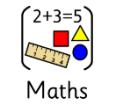
Can you spot any seasonal changes?

Children will be working on number bonds to ten – these are pairs of numbers which add up to a certain number, for example

$9 + 1 = 10$
 $5 + 5 = 10$
 $7 + 3 = 10$

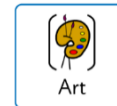


Children can draw their number bonds or build them using Lego, 3 red bricks and 7 blue bricks total 10.

Practice writing numbers to 10, making sure the numbers are the right way round.

Can you make a shelter for a teddy bear? You can draw your design and then create it using materials.



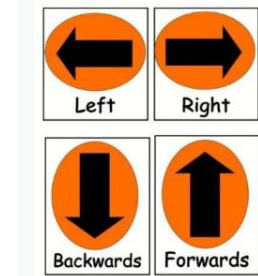
Can you make a shelter for a squirrel? What sort of materials could you use to keep it warm and dry during the winter?
