On **Tuesday 10th February 2026**, we will be taking part in Safer Internet Day, a global event that promotes the safe and positive use of technology for children and young people.



This year's theme is **"Smart tech, safe choices – Exploring the safe and responsible use of AI."** Throughout the week, the children will take part in age-appropriate activities designed to help them begin to understand how to stay safe online and make positive choices when using technology.

What we will be learning in school

During the week, our children will be:

- Talking about what the internet is and how we use it safely
- Learning the importance of keeping personal information private
- Discussing what to do if something online makes them feel worried or upset
- Exploring how to be kind and respectful when using technology
- Beginning simple conversations about smart technology and AI in a child-friendly way

Our aim is to help children build confidence in speaking to a trusted adult and to develop safe habits when using devices.

How you can help at home

You play a vital role in keeping your child safe online.

Here are some simple tips:

- Talk regularly with your child about what they like to do online
- Keep devices in shared family spaces where possible
- Use parental controls and age-appropriate settings on apps and games
- Encourage your child to tell you if anything online worries them
- Remind them never to share personal information or photos without permission
