Try to make a map of your journey, adding in the places that you have seen.	Can you find objects inside or outside of your home and place them into groups of ten? See if you can count how many you have altogether by counting the groups of ten. If you have 3 groups of ten sticks this equals 30 sticks altogether. Write the numbers, making sure to form your numbers correctly.
Can you design and or make a vehicle which can move either on land or water. Your vehicle must be able to hold 10 children.	<u>Bright Lights Big City.</u>	Create a treasure map to find something in your house, see if you can direct someone to find the object, using 'forwards, backwards, right, left, behind, next to, in front of'
Find your favourite song or music and create a dance to this. Try to repeat the moves, making sure to keep in time to the music. Perhaps you could video your dance and add it onto Tapestry.	Download the 'My Happy Mind' app and share this with the children. We are currently working on the 'Relate' module this term.	Record the weather for 5 days and create a weather diary or a TV weather report as a presenter. 'The Weather on Monday was cold with grey skys. Spring in on the way as Tuesday was sunny with some rain.'
