Create an observational collage Begin by creating an observational sketch of a plant or flower of your choice. Then, head outside and select natural materials that you think will be suitable to add to your sketch. Consider which materials are the right shape, colour and texture to enhance your sketch.	Coastlines 	Can you make a pier using different materials (e.g. Lego, newspaper, cardboard, plastic) Have fun and be creative! As a challenge, can you measure your pier?
Play 'Wall Catch' Stand 1m away from the wall. Throw the ball against the wall and try to catch it before it touches the floor. Can you get to 5 catches in a row? Take a step back and repeat.
