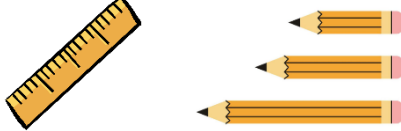

Research a member of the Royal Family. Can you write a fact file about them? Don't forget to include some interesting facts! 	Measure some items around your home using a ruler or a tape measure. Can you order your objects from longest to shortest? 
Find and listen to a piece of music from the time of a past King or Queen. How does the music make you feel? Do you like it? Why / why not? 	<u>Magnificent Monarchs</u> 	Design a crown fit for a King or Queen. What materials will you use to make it? How will you make your crown strong and secure? What precious gemstones will you include? 
Play 'Fill it up!' Players have one pot each that they place 6m apart. Place six socks in the centre. Players start at their pot and run to the middle, taking one sock back to their pot.
