Talk to people in your family. Interview them about their time at school. Find similarities and differences between their school experience and what schools are like now. Some good questions to ask could be:

- What games did you play?
- What lessons did you do?

What was your favourite thing to learn about? Do they have any photos from their school days to look at and compare with yours?



Create a drawing using only half shapes. For example semi circle, half triangle, half square and half rectangle.



Create our own piece of art work inspired by James Rizzi. Think about what features it will include and what colours you will use.

Make a video or poster explaining how you can stay safe online. What rules must you follow (don't tell people where you live, don't talk to strangers, tell a grown up if you see something you don't understand)



Work with someone at home. Can you perform a balance holding hands, with your knees touching or with your elbows touching.
