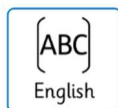


Summer Term 2025 School Days Year 1 Homework Grid

This is your last term in Year 1. Write a message about what you have liked most about being in Year 1 or write about what you are looking forward to in Year 2.



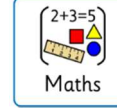
If you want to know something about Year 2 write a question and put it on Tapestry and we will forward onto the teachers to respond.

Create your own song or piece of music. This could be through singing, clapping or playing instruments. Think about the dynamics (how fast or slow it is) and pitch (how high or low it is). Put your performance on Tapestry so that we can all watch you being a musician.



Have fun playing shops! Collect items from around your house to create your shop. Price each item e.g. teddy costs 10p, ball costs 5p. Invite people to bring their money and buy items from your shop.



You could make an open and closed sign and labels for the items you are selling. Remember to count the coins carefully.



In school we are encouraging healthy eating choices. Design a healthy lunchbox. Help make the food and then you could have a picnic with your family.

Collect some data such as how many pens you have in your house. Think of a way to represent your data (different colours), this could be in a tally chart, you could draw a pictogram or create a map.
