COATS AND SUNHATS!

The weather is still a little chilly, rainy and unpredictable at the moment so please can you make sure that you send your child to school with a coat every day.

We are hopeful, however, that the sun will be out soon! When it appears, you may want to send your child in with a named sunhat. On hotter days you may also want your child to wear sun cream. You could either put a long lasting one on at the beginning of the day or send your child in with some sun cream (named). If your child brings in sun cream they must be able to put the cream on themselves.



It all adds up!

Attending school everyday gives your child the best chance of success. 100%

Attending 4½ days a week = 4 weeks learning missed per year 90%

Attending 4 days a week = 8 weeks learning missed per year 80%

Attending 3½ days a week = 12 weeks learning missed per year 70%

80% attendance adds up to missing 2 full years of education over their school life!

Can they afford to keep missing out?

Step 3: Select Booking Mode

Choose *Automatic* if you'd like the system to suggest the shortest possible appointment schedule based on the times you're available to attend. To pick the times to book with each teacher, choose *Manual*. Then press *Next*.

We recommend choosing the automatic booking mode when browsing on a mobile device.

Step 4: Choose Teachers

If you chose the automatic booking mode, drag the sliders at the top of the screen to indicate the earliest and latest you can attend.

Select the teachers you'd like to book appointments with. A green tick indicates they're selected. To de-select, click on their name.

Step 5a (Automatic): Book Appointments

If you chose the automatic booking mode, you'll see provisional appointments which are held for 2 minutes. To keep them, choose Accept at the bottom left.

If it wasn't possible to book every selected teacher during the times you are able to attend, you can either adjust the teachers you wish to meet with and try again, or switch to manual booking mode (Step 5b).

Step 5b (Manual): Book Appointments

Click any of the green cells to make an appointment. Blue cells signify where you already have an appointment. Grey cells are unavailable.

To change an appointment, delete the original by hovering over the blue box and clicking *Delete*. Then choose an alternate time.

You can optionally leave a message for the teacher to say what you'd like to discuss, or raise anything beforehand.

Once you're finished booking all appointments, at the top of the page in the alert box, press *click here* to finish the booking process.
